June 7-19, 2009

Our team of seven arrived in Beijing and then flew on to the very center of China to **Lanzhou**, the capital of Gansu province.

It was from this city of 3.5 million people that LIGHT OF THE WORLD BALLET received an official invitation, through a Christian business person, to perform in a 5-day national investment and trade fair. This allowed us business visas. We were the only American delegation and the only foreign performers.

Here is a summary of the highlights:

Opening Day Ceremony, Dave and Ashley were invited to stand on the VIP platform. As we watched, standing among the vast crowd of Chinese, our group stuck out and became surrounded by press and photographers clamoring to get our photos during the ceremony. This attention may have brought favor. An article appeared in the newspaper.

We had **three afternoons with the Gansu Drama and Dance Boarding School** including a performance and a master class teaching a *Christian* dance. The team had time to make relationship with the precious students.

Our team worked hard, gracefully dancing even with breathing difficulties because of the altitude, but always firm in their commitment to proclaim our Lord.
