# **Emerging Artist Program**

### Developing the Whole Dancer

### March 15-17th 2023

Technique takes endless time and effort, but one also needs to develop their artistry to thrive as a dancer and enhance their technique. Christians know that loving God means engaging with their whole selves- body, mind, and soul. We want to help Christian dancers connect their spiritual lives, artistry, and technique through our new Emerging Artist Program: Developing the whole dancer.

**Ages:** 14-22

**Audition:** We recommend this program for *advanced dancers* who have been en pointe at least two years and attend a minimum of 3 ballet classes per week

\*note: on rare occasions, permission may be obtained for dancers not on pointe due to medical issues, injuries, etc

- Please submit a video audition and application with application fee (via venmo @LightoftheWorldBallet or Paypal by February 1st 2023. Applications will be reviewed once each section has been received (see checklist below).
- 2. Applicants will be informed of acceptance by February 8th 2023 (if a dancer is not accepted into the Emerging Artist Program, we highly recommend Summer Dance Outreach. The programs compliment each other well, and we also encourage attending both if possible!).
- Once an applicant has been accepted into the program, their enrollment will be confirmed with their tuition payment, medical form, and photo release (see below) due Feb 15th 2023.

**Time:** Wednesday-Friday 9:30-5:30 On Friday, the program will end with a worship session and performance by Light of the World Ballet Company; the ending time may be slightly adjusted.

**Classes:** Devotions, Ballet Technique and Pointe, Modern, Classical Variations, Choreographer's Workshop, Creative Development Projects, Improv and Intercession, Creative Worship and Creative Journaling

note- some classes may take place outdoors if weather permits

**Cost:** Upon acceptance, confirmation with medical form, photo release, and tuition payment (due 2/15/23) will secure a dancer's spot in the program.

Tuition: \$325 (\$300 tuition + \$25 materials) payable via Venmo or Paypal

Application Fee: \$25 per student

Optional Fees: LWB T-shirt: \$15 for Child sizes, \$20 for Adult sizes

Application and Video Audition: Due by 2/1/23. LWB will inform applicants via email by 2/8/23 regarding acceptance. Student's tuition payment, medical form, and photo release will secure a spot in the program (due 2/15/23).
